Gentlemen:

We have received copies of Federal Notice of Intention to Drill on your #1 well located in the SW<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub> Section 25-25N-6W.

Will you please re-file copies with this office indicating your proposed cementing program on your surface and production casing.

We are also enclosing a supply of Oil Conservation Commission Forms C-128 which is an acreage dedication plat. Our Dakota spacing rules require that 320 acres, being a half-section, be dedicated to each Dakota prospect. Will you please complete this form, outlining the half-section to be dedicated and answer all questions regarding ownership. The form should be signed by the operator's representative on the right side of the form. As you have already filed a Certificate of Survey it will not be necessary to have Form C-128 signed by the surveyor.

I would also suggest that you fill in on the form a lease name so that the well may be more easily identified. Most operators use the original lessee for this purpose on Federal land.

of Survey it will not be necessary to have Form C-128 signed by the  
surveyor.

leases for this purpose on Federal land.
