Reference is made to your application for permission to flare or vent low pressure casinghead gas from your E. H. Heggie Well No. 1 located in the SW/4 NE/4 of Section 8, and your R. L. Hairston Well No. 2, located in the SW/4 SE/4 of Section 6, both in Township 24 North, Range 9 West, San Juan County, New Mexico, in the Bisti-Lower Gallup Oil Pool.

By authority granted me under provisions of Order No. R-1427, you are hereby authorized to flare gas from the above described wells until January 1, 1962.

In the future if you secure a connection for your gas, you must file an amended C-110 showing the applicable information. If you have not filed Form C-110, please do so immediately in compliance with the rule.

Prior to January 1, 1962, please furnish the Santa Fe office of the Commission with a progress report of your efforts to eliminate the flaring or venting of gas from the above described wells. Failure to do so will subject the wells to cancellation of allowable.
