TIGHT HOLE: IT IS REQUESTED THAT NO INFORMATION BE RELEASED

This proposal is to drill a wildcat well in SW/4 Section 13, T24N, R12W, N.M.P.M., San Juan County, N.M. to approximate depth of 1000 feet to test the Pictured Cliff and/or Fruitland formation. This proposal is to drill a 4 3/4" hole to TD and, if possible, to core the zone from 800 feet to 850 feet. If warranted, a drill stem test will be performed. If suitable production is indicated, 2 7/8" production tubing will be cemented and usual control head valves installed. 2 joints of 5 1/2" J55 (64') will be cemented at surface, with cement circulated, and pressured tested for 24 hours. up.

IN ABOVE SPACE DESCRIBE PROPOSED PROGRAM: If proposal is to deepen or plug back, give data on present productive zone and proposed new productive zone. General: This form is designed for submitting proposals to perform certain well operations, as indicated, on all types of lands and leases for appropriate action by either a Federal or a State agency, or both, pursuant to applicable Federal and/or State laws and regulations. Any necessary special instructions concerning the use of this form and the number of copies to be submitted, particularly with regard to local, area, or regional procedures and practices, either are shown below or will be issued by, or may be obtained from, the local Federal and/or State office.

Item 1: If the proposal is to redrill to the same reservoir at a different subsurface location or to a new reservoir, use this form with appropriate notations. Consult applicable State or Federal regulations concerning subsequent work proposals or reports on the well.

Item 4: If there are no applicable State requirements, locations on Federal or Indian land should be described in accordance with Federal requirements. Consult local State or Federal office for specific instructions.

Item 14: Needed only when location of well cannot readily be found by road from the land or lease description. A plat, or plats, separate or on this reverse side, showing the roads to, and the surveyed location of, the well, and any other required information, should be furnished when required by Federal or State agency offices.

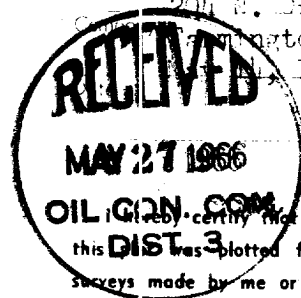

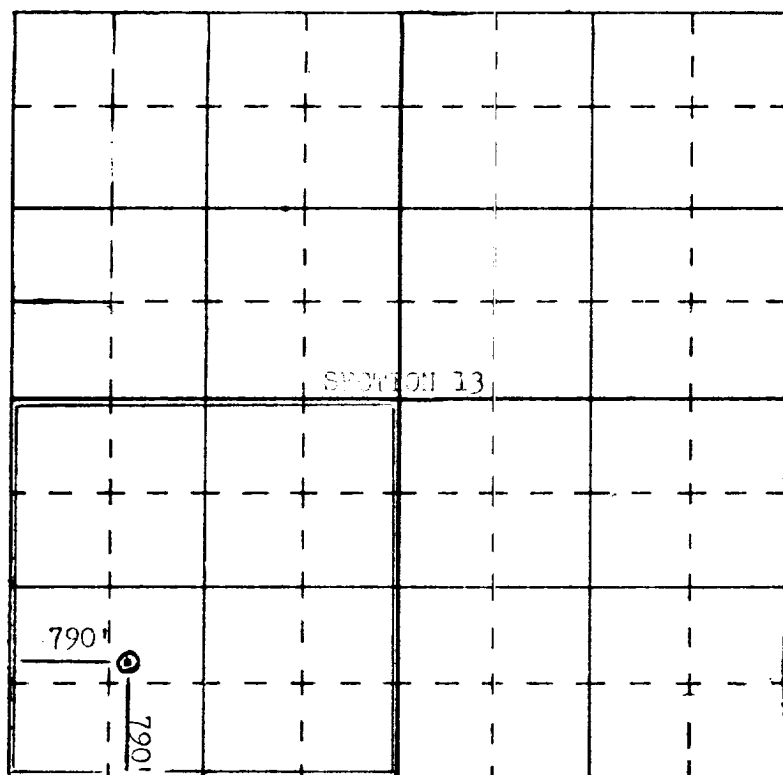
