The operator requests continued long term shut-in status. We have installed a pump jack on this well to remove water so that gas can be produced. Sand production from the fracturing operation has caused problems with continual pumping. The operator is exploring several remedies to halt sand production and test the well. Adjacent Fruitland Coal wells have responded well to removing water by pumping. This well will be an economically viable well when the current production problems can be resolved.
