Dear Sir:

We are approving the Notice of Intention to Drill on your #1-36 Albuquerque-State well in Section 36-25N-7W. We are accepting your acreage dedication plat which shows 320 acres, being the East half of Section 36, dedicated to this well. I would like to point out, however, that the Oil Conservation Commission spacing requirements on wildcat wells or in any of the existing Pictured Cliffs pools stipulate that 160 acres, being a quarter-section be dedicated to each well. I therefore have no authority to approve your acreage dedication of 320 acres. However, as there is no proration in this area at the present time the problem is not immediate. Undoubtedly Superior Oil Company will be required to call a hearing to consider the establishment of 320-acre units in this pool if that is what they desire.

We are returning the Notice of Intention to Drill on your #1 Skelly-Truby-Government well until such time as you are ready to drill this well.
