NOTICE TO ALL OPERATORS IN THE SAN JUAN BASIN

There is a possibility of proration being imposed on gas wells in the San Juan Basin in the foreseeable future. In this event it will be necessary that the Gil Conservation Commission have on file Form C-104 (Request for Allowable) and gas well plate showing designated production units for all wellslisted on the proration schedule. We are therefore sending all operators a supply of these forms and request that each operator file them on all producing wells on which they have not been filed, regardless of completion date. A previous memorandum issued by the Commission excepted all wells completed prior to November, 1952, from filing Form C-104. Therefore, in most cases we will lack Form C-104 on wells completed prior to that date.

if an operator is undecided as to which wells are lacking Form C-104 the information may be obtained from the District III office of the Cil Conservation Commission, Box 697, Astec, New Mexico.
