The name of the above well has been changed from Jicarilla Apache 118 "A" Well No. 4 to Jicarilla Apache "A" 118 Well No. 4.

The above well was spudded on April 15, 1962 and drilled to a depth of 212' 8-5/8" casing was set at that depth with 125 sacks Incon cement containing 2% calcium chloride. Cement circulated to surface. After waiting on cement tested casing with 300 psi. Test o.k. Reduced hole to 7-7/8" at 212' and resumed drilling
