DETAILS OF WORK

As a result of not obtaining gas in commercial quantities, the above well was plugged and abandoned October 10, 1962 as follows:

1. Pumped 25 sacks cement plug on bottom and squeezed with 500 psi.
2. Filled hole with fluid.
3. Pumped 25 sacks cement down 8-5/8"-4-1/2" annulus.
4. Spotted 5 sacks cement plug at surface.
5. Erected abandonment marker and cleaned up location
