Re: Request for Marginal Classification and
Exception to Annual Deliverability Test
Requirement for "C" Well 2-29, Blanco
Mesaverde Gas Pool.

Gentlemen:

Northwest Production Corporation "C" well 2-29, located in the NW/4 SW/4 Section 29, T-26-N, R-4-W, Rio Arriba County, New Mexico, was completed April 15, 1957, as a dual Mesaverde-Dakota gas well. On August 19, 1959, the Dakota zone was temporarily abandoned after being logged off with water for some two months.

"C" well 2-29, Mesaverde is presently producing through 2-3/8" OD tubing at a rate of approximately 75 MCFOPD with an estimated five barrels of fluid, 90% water. The well is scheduled for 1959 Annual Deliverability Test, with conditioning period to commence on October 8, 1959. Because of the small volume of gas and large amount of liquid being produced, it is thought that after a shut-in period of seven days, sufficient fluid will accumulate to log off the well and that it will be necessary to swab following shut-in if production is to be restored.

If view of the above, it is requested that "C" well 2-29 be given a Marginal classification and that it be excepted from the Annual Deliverability Test requirement.

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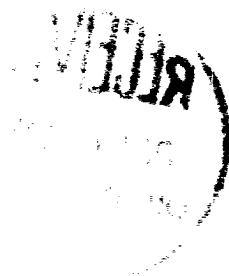
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
