DETAILS OF WORK

1. Spudded 5-20-56. 9-5/8" casing at 200 with 150 sacks on May 21, 1956. Drilled plug and tested with 500# pressure with no leaks on May 22, 1956.
2. Cemented 4-1/2" casing at 3049 with 150 sacks on June 1, 1956.
3. Perforated 112 shots 3786-3814 on 7-17-56, squeezed perforations with 50 sacks on July 19, 1956. Re-perforated 112 shots 3786-3814 and sand water fractured through perforations with 20000 gallons water and 20000# sand, BDP 2100#, IR 31.9 bpm on July 24, 1956.
4. Ran 2" tubing to 3750 on July 24, 1956.

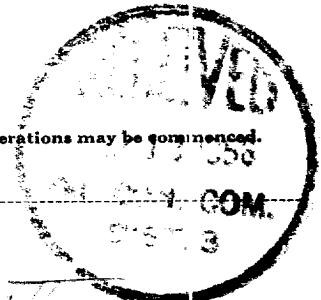
