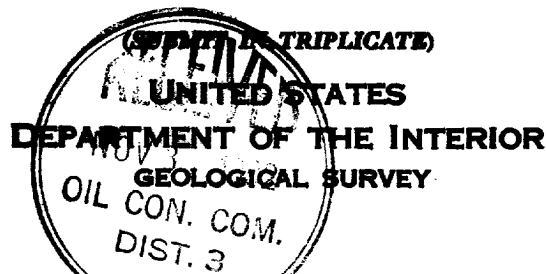

The objective sand is the Pictured Cliffs. It is expected about 3060 feet. The casing program is as follows:

200' of 3-1/8" O.D. casing cemented to surface
 3060' of 2 1/2" O.D. casing cemented with 50 sacks.

Well will be drilled with rotary tools to the top of the Pictured Cliffs sands and at this point 2 1/2" casing will be set. The way was will be drilled with cable tools to total depth of approximately 3230'.

The well will be shot with nitro glycerine from 3100' to total depth.

A 1" siphon line will be installed to total depth.

I understand that this plan of work must receive approval in writing by the Geological Survey before operations may be commenced.

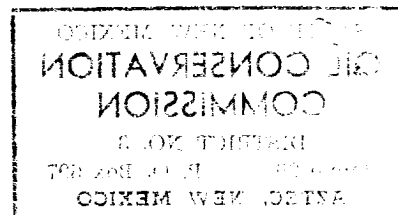

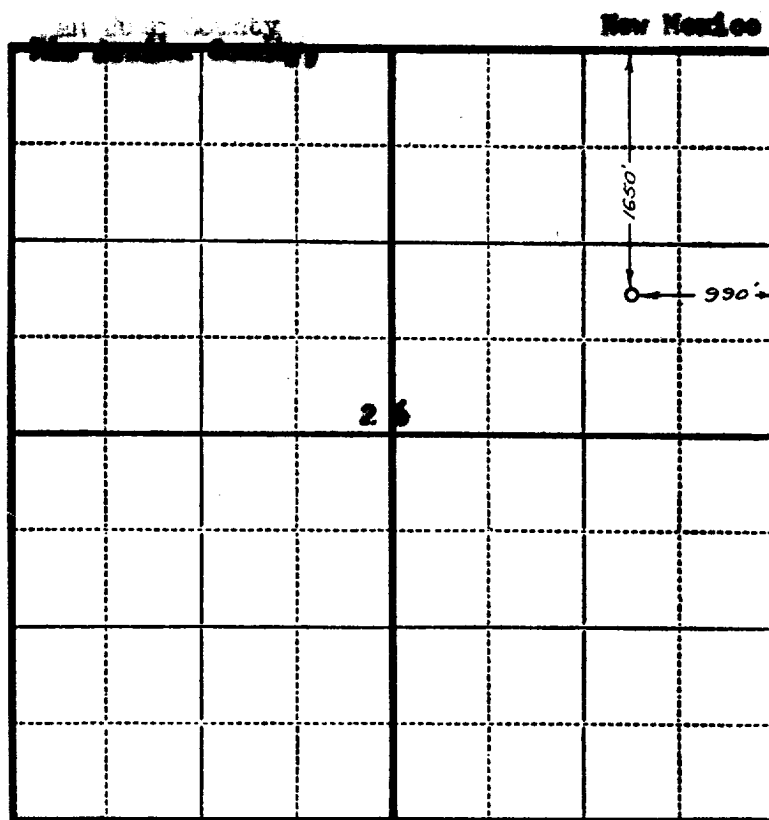
