1. Rig up and spud 15" surface hole 2:00 P.M. 8/30/61.
2. Drilled T.D. of 304'
3. Ran 9 joints 10-3/4" OD, 32.75# H-40 surface casing. Landed at 297' R.K.B. Cemented with 275 sz. regular cement w/2% calcium chloride. Plug down @ 1:00 A.M. 8/30/61. Cement circulated to surface.
4. Pressured up on surface csg. to 1000 psi, for 30 minutes. Press. held 8/31/61.
5. Drilling ahead in 9-7/8" hole.
