Complying with request in your letter under date of July 26, 1957, relative to the subject matter, please be advised of the following:

In our dual completion of the subject well, we will set a Baker Model "D" production packer approximately 50' above Mesa Verde perforations. The Mesa Verde will be completed through 2" tubing run through the production packer. The Pictured Cliffs will be completed by running 2" tubing to approximately 25' above Pictured Cliffs perforations.
