The Joint Commission on Conservation was organized in 1953 by the Texas Game and Fish Commission and the Texas Parks and Wildlife Department. Its purpose is to coordinate the conservation efforts of these two agencies and to advise them on matters of common interest. The Commission has held several public hearings and has received many suggestions from the public. It has also conducted extensive research on various conservation problems and has issued numerous reports and bulletins. The Commission is currently working on a comprehensive plan for the conservation of the state's natural resources.

The Commission is composed of representatives from the Texas Game and Fish Commission, the Texas Parks and Wildlife Department, and the public. It is headed by a Chairman and has a Secretary. The Commission meets regularly and holds public hearings on matters of interest. It is a non-profit organization and its funds are derived from the sale of its publications and from donations. The Commission is committed to the conservation of the state's natural resources and to the improvement of the state's environment.
