Dear Mr. Arnold:

Reference is made to your letter of November 25, 1964, to our Mr. John H. Watkins in which you requested certain information on the captioned well. Confirming our telephone conversation of this date, please be advised that at the time the subject well was drilled, Delhi-Taylor Oil Corporation and The Atlantic Refining Company (one-half interest each) owned all of the operating rights in the Dakota formation in all of the acreage dedicated to this well. Since all of the acreage dedicated to the well is contained in one lease, there was no need for communitization. Delhi-Taylor operated the lease and two other Jicarilla leases for itself and Atlantic under an operating agreement dated August 11, 1953. For your information the current ownership of the subject well is Atlantic, one-half interest; Continental Oil Company, one-fourth interest; and Tenneco Oil Company, one-fourth interest, with Tenneco as operator.

The other information requested in your letter is being forwarded to your office today under separate cover.

We hope that the foregoing will satisfactorily clear up any questions that you had. However, please do not hesitate to call on us if you desire any additional information.
