

from the Dogie Canyon-Pictured Cliffs Pool as set out in your letter.**

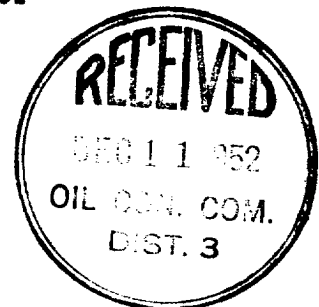
