
Attached are the remainder of the annual packer leakage tests for those wells scheduled for test in our letter of April 3, 1959.

It will be noted that Flow Test No. 2 was terminated one day early on those wells which had the Pictured Cliffs flowing from June 12 to June 19. The termination was requested by the pipeline company in order to make repairs to their system. We believe the six-day flow period was sufficient to give indication of any communication. We trust that these tests will be acceptable.

The test on our Jicarilla "D" No. 5, Sec. 14, T26N, R3W, indicated some degree of communication. We suspect that the lift valves (with sleeves), installed in the Mesaverde tubing string for original unloading, are the source of communication. We plan to check the sleeves with a wireline and run the test again. You will be notified of the test schedule.
