It is proposed to clean well out to 2380' and then cement 2 7/8" OD EUE Liner from approx 2200' to 2380'.

Liner will be perforated opposite PC sand and then sand water frac'ed with approx 50,000 # sand.

Some new surface will need to be disturbed to repair location. This location sits on edge of Largo Wash and it is proposed to cut location down approx 4' to build pad around well head approx 20' out in Largo Wash.

It is also proposed to install car bodies in edge of fill to turn water away from wellhead location.

A small pit on location will be required while cleaning out well and to contain frac water after treating.
