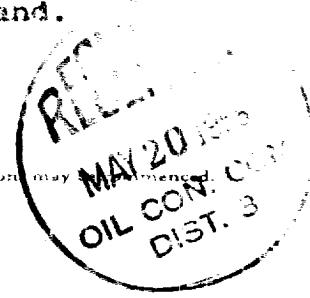
550' test for Base Dakota at lesser depth.

5. **11'** core & test Greenhorn lime and 1st Dakota Sand.

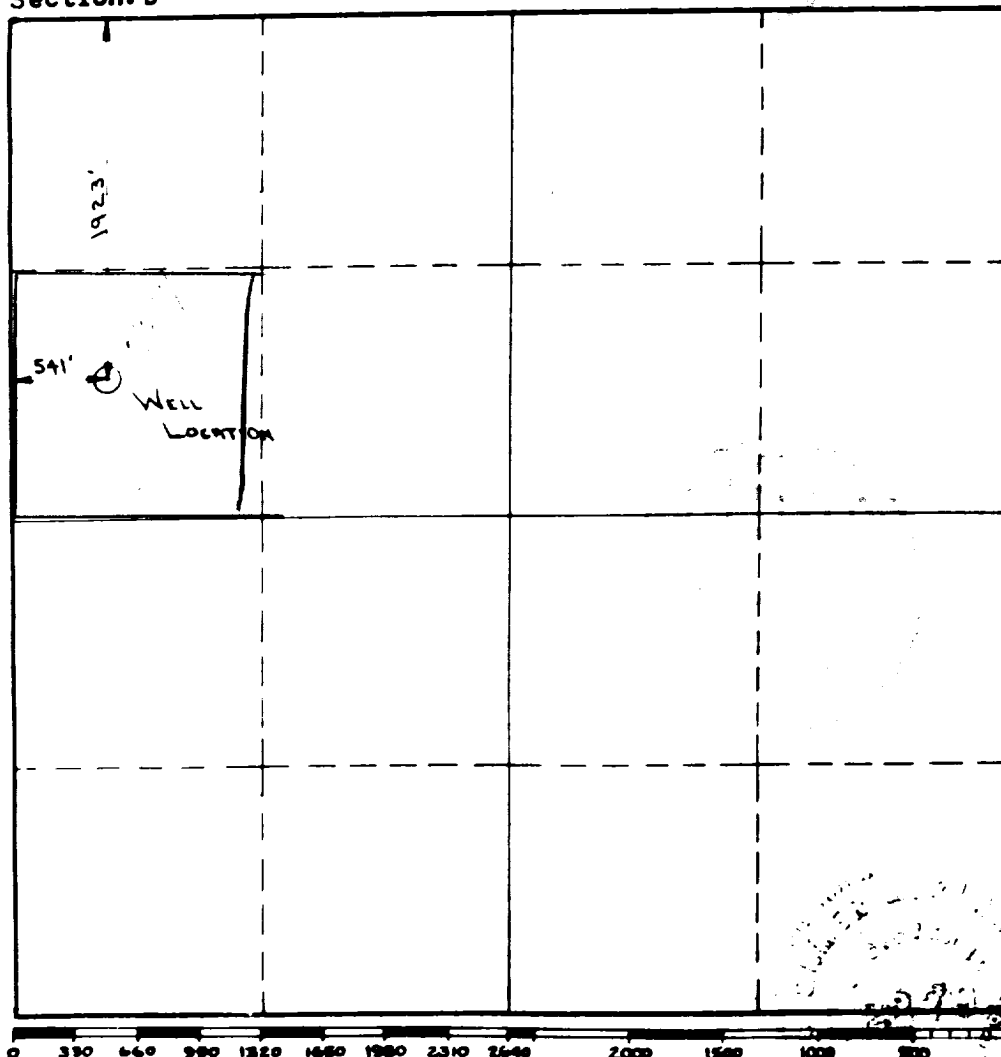
