THE APPLICATION OF COMSOLIDATED OIL & GAS, INC. FOR A DUAL COMPLETION.

ORDER NO. MC-1671

ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER OF THE OIL COMMERVATION COMMISSION

Under the provisions of Rule 112-A, Consolidated Oil & Gas, Inc., made application to the New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission on September 16, 1965, for permission to dually complete its Jenney Well No. 1 located in Unit B of Section 13, Township 26 North, Range 4 West, HMPM, Rio Arriba County, New Mexico, in such a manner as to produce gas from the Blanco-Mesaverde Pool and the Basin-Dakota Pool.

Now, on this 21st day of October, 1965, the Secretary-Director finds:

- (1) That application has been duly filed under the provisions of Rule 112-A of the Commission's Rules and Regulations;
- (2) That satisfactory information has been provided that all operators of offset acreage have been duly notified; and
- (3) That no objections have been received within the waiting period as prescribed by said rule.
- (4) That the proposed dual completion will not cause waste nor impair correlative rights.
- (5) That the mechanics of the proposed dual completion are feasible and consonant with good conservation practices.

IT IS THEREFORE CEDERED:

That the applicant herein, Consolidated Oil & Gas, Inc., be and the same is hereby authorised to dually complete its Jenney Well No. 1 located in Unit B of Section 13, Township 26 North, Range 4 West, MMPM, Rio Arriba County, New Mexico, in such a manner as to produce gas from the Blanco-Mesaverde Pool and the Basin-Dakota Pool through parallel strings of tubing.

provided HOMEVER. That applicant shall complete, operate, and produce said well in accordance with the provisions of Rule 112-A.

PROVIDED FURTHER. That applicant shall take packer-leakage tests upon completion and annually thereafter during the Annual Deliverability Test Period for the Basin-Dakota Pool.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED: That jurisdiction of this cause is hereby retained for the entry of such further orders as the Commission may deem necessary.
