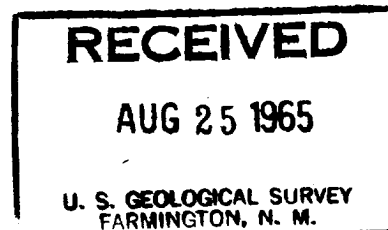
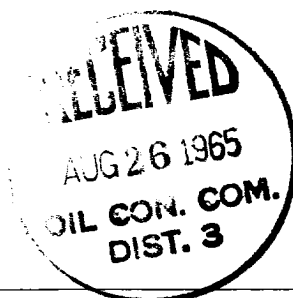

Spudded in at 11:00 AM. 8-4-65. Drilled 321' of 13 3/4" hole. Ran 11 joints of 9 5/8" 32# casing. Cemented with 170 sacks of regular with 2% Ca Cl₂. Plug down 7:00 PM. 8-4-65. Good returns. Had drilled 8 3/4" hole to 3700' ran 94 joints of 7" 23# cemented with 56 sacks of 90-90 Pozmix with 2% gal, and 1/8# cello flakes per sack. Tailed in with 25 sacks of regular with 2% Ca Cl₂. We had to squeeze well again with 100 sacks of regular with 4% Ca Cl₂. Pressured to 2500# held OK. Gas drilled from 3700' to 8030' ran 251 joints of 4 1/2" top to bottom and 1 joint of 5 1/2" 15.50# on top. Cemented 1st stage with 53 sacks and 53 sacks of Dia Mix "A" and 1/8# cello flakes per sack plug down at 11:15 AM 8-22-65. Cemented second stage at 5877 with 44 sacks Dia Mix 4% gal 1/8# and 44 sacks of type "C" 1/8# per sack cello flakes. Good returns. Pressured to 2000# held OK.

Instructions

General: This form is designed for submitting proposals to perform certain well operations, and reports of such operations when completed, as indicated, on Federal and Indian lands pursuant to applicable Federal law and regulations, and, if approved or accepted by any State, on all lands in such State, pursuant to applicable State law and regulations. Any necessary special instructions concerning the use of this form and the number of copies to be submitted, particularly with regard to local, area, or regional procedures and practices, either are shown below or will be issued by, or may be obtained from, the local Federal and/or State office.
