TD--6645'. 7" 23# J-55 Smls Csg. at 6591' with 200 sacks. Top of cement 5066'. Open hole 6591' to 6645'.

Abandoned as Tocito producer 11-1-63.

It is now proposed to deepen well to Dakota Zone at approx 7400'; then run 4 1/2" 11.6# liner from approx 6500' to TD. Hole will be Caliper Logged so liner can be cemented with sufficient, Cement to circulate. 7" casing will be perforated at 6560' and then cemented from 5060' to surface by circulating and squeezing.

Well will be completed in Chacra, Mesa Verde and Dakota Zones, with packer between Mesa Verde and Dakota Zones to Dual Complete.

This well will be a Dakota Infil well as approved in Order No. R-1670-V.

To conform with numbering of Infil wells this well No. changed from 677 to 204E.

2 3/8" 4.7# EUE 8rd tubing will be run thru packer to Dakota perforation. 1 1/4" 2.3# NU 10rd tubing will be run to Mesa Verde perforations for commingled Chacra, Mesa Verde Production.

A Shaffer 10" Model LWP, 6000# test, 3000# WP BOP will be in use at all times while deepening and cementing well. BOP will be tested at least once during each 24 hr day.

No new surface to be disturbed. Old location will be dressed off and old reserve pit will be rebuilt to contain drilling fluids and frac water while drilling and completing.

All disturbed area will be cleaned up and reseeded to within 5' of all facilities with BLM approved seeding program.

This acreage dedicated to Gas Company of New Mexico in all three zones.

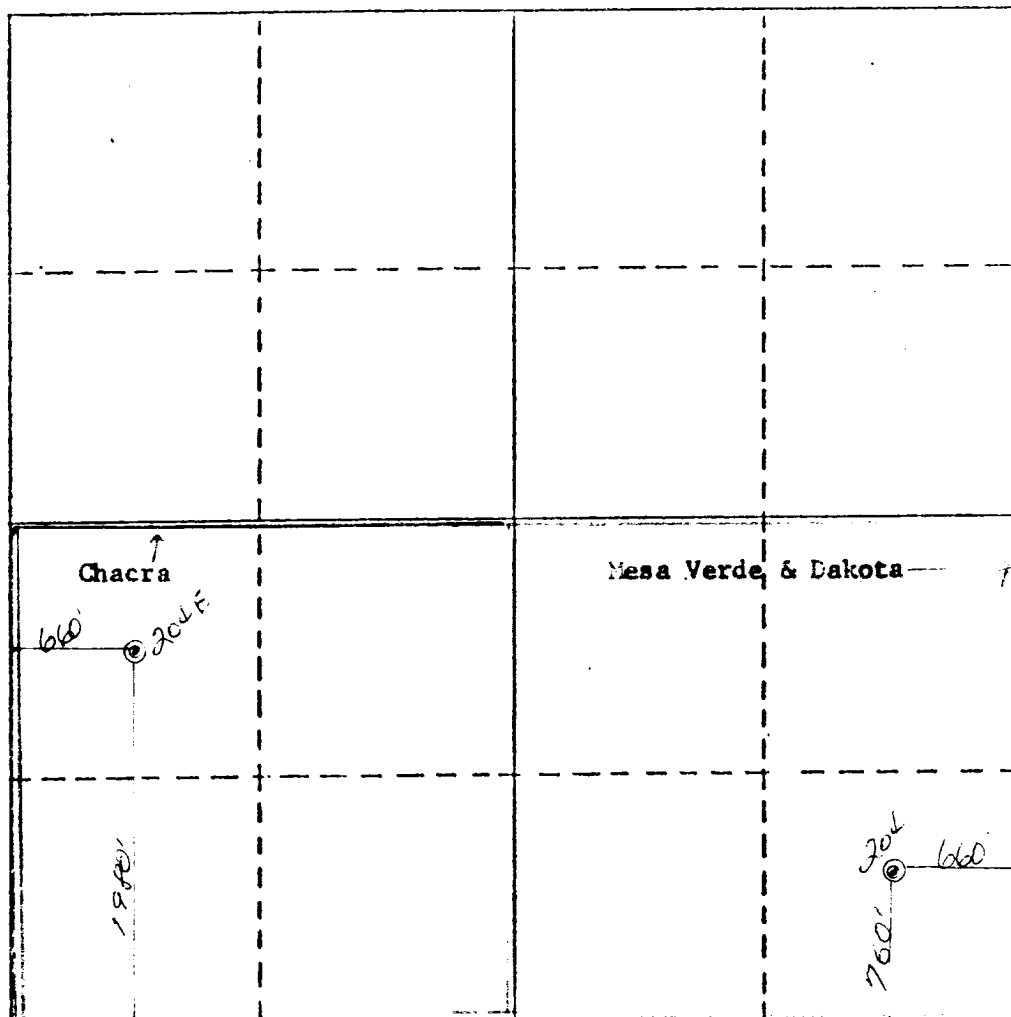
