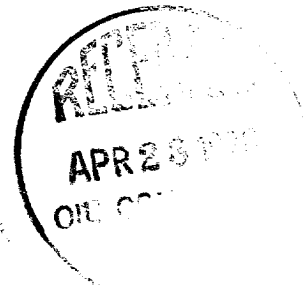
Please submit Sundry Notices advising of your plans for this well. A request to continue temporary abandonment should include justification for such status.
