Gentlemen:

We have received annual packer leakage test on Magnolia's
Jicarilla "U" #3 well in unit H, Section 8-26N-3W, Rio
Arriba County, New Mexico.

In our opinion the results of this test as indicated by the
measured pressures is inconclusive. During the week in which
the Pictured Cliffs Formation was produced into the line the
Mesaverde pressure appears to have declined 19%. While this
does not seem to indicate a large leak it does indicate the
possibility of communication.

We are therefore directing that another packer leakage test
be scheduled on this well in order that it might be determined
if the zones are separated. Please schedule the new test
with this office in writing, in order that the test may be wit-
nessed by the Commission.
