Dear Mr. Arnold:

Your correspondence of May 3, 1963 indicated that, after an evaluation of our Pictured Cliffs restimulation of Jicarilla C-#3, Sec. 8, T.26N, R.3W, the Commission be notified as to Mobil's intentions with regard to remedial work on Jicarilla H-#3, Sec. 12, T.26N, R.3W, in which a packer leak between the Pictured Cliffs and the Mesaverde formations has been reported.

The C-#3 recompletion has increased Pictured Cliffs production from ± 50 Mcf/D to ± 100 Mcf/D. However, because of the high investment required for the frac job, such an increase does not make similar future projects economically feasible.

In view of these results, and since H-#3 may be considered as sub-commercial in the Mesaverde (± 10 Mcf/D) and has never been capable of production from the Pictured Cliffs, it has now been decided to abandon both zones permanently. Specific details of the abandonment program will be forwarded to your office on the appropriate forms prior to commencing the job.
