9/3/63 Moved in & rigged up.
9/4/63 Pulled Pictured Cliffs tubing from 3565'.
9/6/63 Spun out through Muscovite tubing 50 mm 3110/3295', final press 2500 psi.
Spotted 5 mm cement on top of packer 3360/3410'. Spotted 25 mm cement 3500/3700'. Spotted 10 mm cement 3810/3856'.
9/12/63 Shot & recovered 7-5/8" casing from 1060'. Spotted 20 mm cement 1010/1060'.
9/13/63 Spotted 10 mm cement at surface inside 10-1/4" casing. Erected a 4-1/2" steel pipe monument & cleaned location except for El Paso's Production Unit & pit. A subsequent Report of Abandonment will be filed when El Paso's equipment & pit are cleaned up.

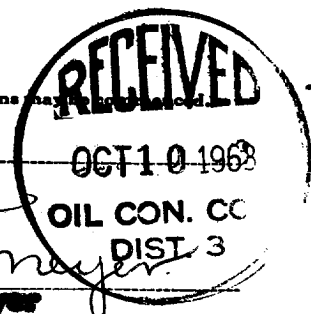
