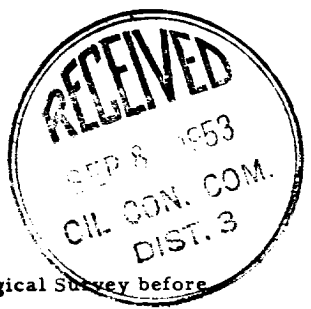
DETAILS OF WORK

Drill 13 3/4 inch Rotary hole to 150'. Set 10 3/4 inch and circulate out with 250 sacks.

Drill 8 3/4 inch hole to top of Tocito, approximately 8000'. Set 7 inch, 23' with 250 sacks.

Drill 6 1/4 inch hole through Tocito pay and test same.
