In compliance with New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission Order No. R-1414, Rule No. 7, the El Paso Natural Gas Products Company will run a 72 hour production test on the Rincon Unit No. 11, SE/4 SW/4 of Section 6, Township 26N, Range 6W, Rio Arriba County, New Mexico. This test will commence at 8:00 A.M. December 14, 1959 and end at 8:00 A.M. December 17, 1959. The final 24 hour producing period will commence at 8:00 A.M. December 16, 1959 and end at 8:00 A.M. December 17, 1959.

The purpose of this test is to transfer the allowable from this well to other wells in the Rincon Unit. The Rincon Unit No. 11 will be converted to a water injection well at some date in the near future.
