Dear Mr. Arnold:

We hereby request a special test period for the Dakota in the Consolidated Tribal "C" No. 1-6 located in the SW/4 of Section 6, Township 26 North, Range 3 West, Rio Arriba County, New Mexico.

Preliminary 24-hour tests against a back pressure regulator have indicated that this well is not capable of bucking the 500 pound line pressures in the area. We request a thirty-day test period to flare this well and produce the oil to determine whether or not we can justify a compressor or whether this well will have an increasing GOR which will permit it to buck the line pressures.

Your early consideration of this matter will be greatly appreciated.
