OF THE OIL CONSERVATION COMMISSION

Under the provisions of Rule 112-A, Consolidated Oil & Gas, Inc. made application to the New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission on March 24, 1962, for permission to dually complete its Tribal "C" Well No. 1-6 located in the 5%/4 5%/4 of Section 6, Township 26 North, Range 3 West, NMPM, Rio Arriba County, New Mexico, in such a manner as to permit the production of gas from the Tapacito-Pictured Cliffs Pool and the production of gas from the Basin-Dakota Pool.

Now, on this 16th day of April, 1962, the Secretary-Director finds:

- (1) That application has been duly filed under the provisions of Rule 112-A of the Commission's Rules and Regulations;
- (2) That satisfactory information has been provided that all operators of offset acreage have been duly notified; and
- (3) That no objections have been received within the waiting period as prescribed by said rule.
- (4) That the proposed dual completion will not cause waste nor impair correlative rights.
- (5) That the mechanics of the proposed dual completion are feasible and consommt with good conservation practices.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

That the applicant herein, Consolidated Oil & Gas, Inc., be and the same is hereby authorized to dually complete its Tribal "C" Well No. 1-6 located in the SW/G SW/4 of Section 6, Township 26 North, Range 3 West, NMPM, Rio Arriba County, New Mexico, in such a manner as to permit the production of gas from the Tapacito-Pictured Cliffs Pool and the production of gas from the Basin-Dakota Pool through parallel strings of tubing.
