Here are completed C-122-A on the following listed wells:

These tests are calculated as suggested by Mr. Emery Arnold and Mr. Al Kindrick of the New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission.

These forms have been completed using the best available data from Pacific Northwest Pipe Line Company charts. In our opinion, the wells did not have sufficient continuous flow during the conditioning period, and the flow period was not long enough to give a representative initial deliverability test on either completion. The production was erratic and discontinuous because of freezing conditions, and dehydrator mal-functions.

For these reasons, we feel that these Initial Deliverability Tests should be considered in error, and the wells continued in production until such time as a proper Initial Deliverability test can be conducted. At that time an allowable can be calculated back to the first delivery of the well.
