TD 7700'. FOLLOW INSTRUCTIONS IN THE RULES AND REGULATIONS OF THE COMMISSION
Cemented 5½" casing at 7700' with 750 sks cement as follows:
1st Stage Thru Shoe - 450 sks 12% bentonite cement containing 12½# gilsonite
per sack followed by 100 sks Latex cement containing 12½# gilsonite per sk.
2nd State thru stage collar at 3283 - 200 sks 12% bentonite cement
Top of Pictured Cliffs Sand 3125'.
5½" OD - 17# J-55 Casing 6676 to 7700'
5½" OD - 15.5# J-55 Casing 0 to 6676'.
Centralizers at 7695, 7600, 7504, 7407, 7312, 3324 and 3243
Howco Roto Wall Scratchers 7300 to 7700'.

Casing will be tested May 19, 1961, then perforated in selected intervals between 7340
and 7640. Perforations ~~will~~ will be sand water fractured with 180,000# sand.
