Gentlemen:

Reference is made to your recent application for permission to commingle
in the well-bore production from the BS Mesa-Gallup and Basin-Dakota Gas
Pools under the terms of Oil Conservation Commission Order No. R-4059.

It appearing that the subject wells qualify for approval for such commingling in the well-bore, and that reservoir damage or waste will not result from such down-hole commingling, and correlative rights will not be violated thereby, you are hereby authorized to commingle the production as described above and Commission Order Nos. MC-1771 and MC-1856 which authorized the dual completions and required separation of the zones, is hereby placed in abeyance.

Assignment of allowables to the wells and allocation of production from the wells shall be determined in accordance with the procedure described by Commission Order No. R-4059, paragraph 2.

Pursuant to the terms of Commission Order No. R-4059, the commingling authority granted by this order may be rescinded by the Secretary-Director if, in his opinion, conservation is not being best served by such commingling.
