ORDER OF THE COMMISSION

BY THE COMMISSION:

This cause came on for hearing at 9 o'clock a.m. on March 11, 1964, at Santa Fa, New Mexico, before Smaminer Daniel 3. Wetter.

HOW, on this $18\pi k$ day of March, 1964, the Commission, a quorum being present, having considered the testimony, the record, and the recommendations of the Examiner, and being fully advised in the promises,

FINDS:

- (1) That due public notice having been given as required by law, the Commission has jurisdiction of this cause and the subject matter thereof.
- authority to complete its <u>Boyt Well No. 2-5. located in Unit Lof</u> section 5. Township 26 North, Range 4 Nest, MMPM, Rio Arribe County, New Mexico, as a triple completion (conventional) to produce gas from the Basin-Dahota Gas Pool, an undesignated Gallup Gas Pool, and the Blanco-Messaverde Gas Pool through parallel strings of 2 1/16-inch, 1 1/2-inch, and 1-inch tubing, respectively, with separation of somes by packers set at approximately 7690 feet and 7905 feet.
- (3) That the mechanics of the proposed triple completion are feasible and in accord with good conservation practices.
- (4) That approval of the subject application will prevent waste and protect correlative rights.

IT IS THEREPORE ORDERED!

(1) That the applicant, Consolidated Oil & Gas, Inc., is hereby authorized to complete its Boyt Well Bo. 2-5, located in

Unit L of Section 5, Township 26 North, Range 4 Nest, NMPM, Ric Arriba County, New Mexico, as a triple completion (conventional) to produce gas from the Basin-Dakota Gas Pool, an undesignated Gallup gas pool, and the Blanco-Mesaverde Gas Pool through parallel strings of 2 1/16-inch, 1 1/2-inch, and I-inch tubing, respectively, with separation of somes by packers set at approximately 7690 feet and 7905 feet;

PROVIDED HOWEVER, that the applicant shall complete, operate, and produce said well in accordance with the provisions of Rule 112-A of the Commission Rules and Regulations insofar as said rule is not inconsistent with this order;

<u>PROVIDED FURTHER</u>, that the applicant shall take packerleakage tests upon completion and annually thereafter during the Gas-Oil Batic Test Period for the Basim-Dakota Gas Pool.

(2) That jurisdiction of this cause is retained for the entry of such further orders as the Commission may deem necessary.
