Your letter of Movember 21, 1962 in answer to our letter of Oct. 2, 1962 requests permission to leave your well No. 1 Intex 5 completed as it is, or to allow you additional time in which to produce the Gallup and Sanestee sones before being required to plug off the Greenhorn and Graneres sones. We can not agree with you that cavings form an effective plug, however, the M.M.O.C.C. and the U.S.G.S. have agreed to allow you a reasonable length of time in which to check the producing capabilities of the zones now being produced. The time allowed will be from 3 to 6 months depending on the behavior of the well under sustained production and, of course, weather and road conditions in the area in which the well is located.
