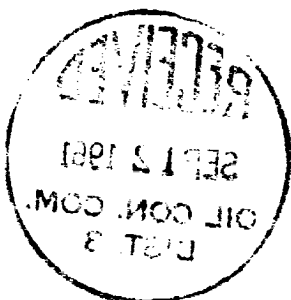

Dear Mr. Porter:

Occidental Petroleum Corporation requested administrative approval to drill a Mesa Verde-Dakota dual on an unorthodox location 2460' FSL and 1460' FWL of Section 6, T26N - R5W, Rio Arriba County, New Mexico. Permission for this unorthodox location was granted by N.S.L. 268 dated August 11, 1961.

Occidental now plans to drill a Pictured Cliffs well, as well as the Mesa Verde-Dakota dual, on the same location. The Pictured Cliffs well will be located 2460' FSL and 1510' FWL of Section 6, T26N - R5W, Rio Arriba County, New Mexico. Occidental Petroleum Corporation is requesting administrative approval for the Pictured Cliffs unorthodox location because of the extreme topography in the area as indicated on the attached plat.

We have not notified our offset operators because the entire Section 6 is operated by Occidental and the unorthodox location will not crowd the offset operators.

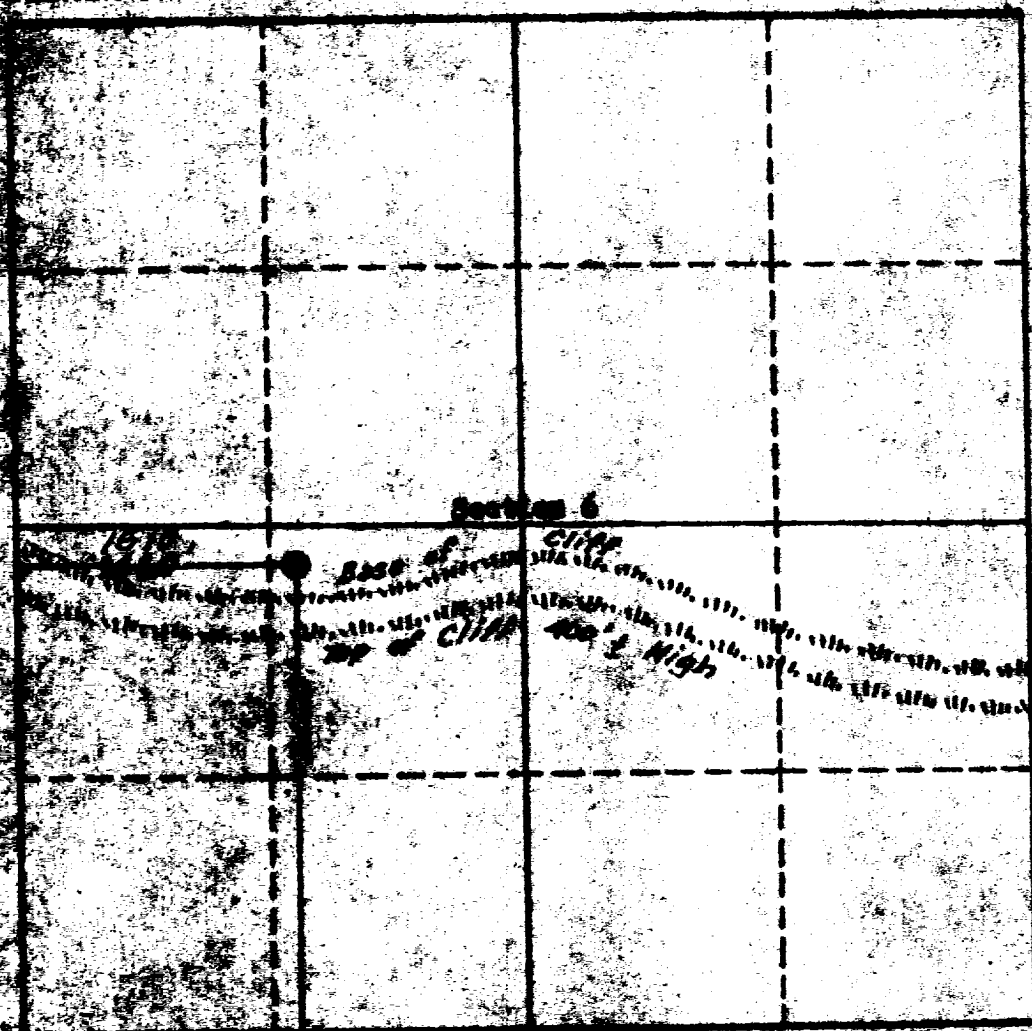
