6/8/56: Set 511', 15 Jts., 8-5/8" casing at 525' w/200 sacks AS calcium chloride cement. and w/350 sacks cement, outside of pipe. PCE at 10:00 A.M., 6/8/56. Ran temperature survey w/indeterminate results.

6/9/56: Pressured up to test casing - would not hold. Ran bit and found no cement in pipe. Set drillable retainer at 466'. Squashed with 440 sacks neat cement w/300# pr. Job completed at 12:15 A.M., 6/10/56.

6/10/56: Tested casing w/650# for 30 minutes. Test O.K.
