

Dear Tom:

Both 1992 and 1993 Packer Leakage Tests on the referenced wells indicate packer or tubing leaks. Meridian Oil Inc was directed to initiate remedial activity on both wells in 1992. I have had no reply from your office and apparently no action has been taken. I realize you have many recompletions, workovers and P&A's, plus your bradenhead pressure remediation program and probably do not consider these wells to be top priority. However, as they have been carried over from last year, I urge you to move on them as soon as possible to prevent stronger action from being necessitated.
