Gentlemen:

Johnston-Shear 26-3, well #1-3 Mesaverde, located in the NE/4 Section 3, T-26-N, R-3-W, Rio Arriba County, New Mexico, was shut in by the Commission on March 1, 1960 for non-curtailement of over-production. The well is scheduled for Annual Deliverability Test in Area 13, with flow week from May 15 to May 22.

Will you please release well #1-3 Mesaverde from the shut-in order for the purpose of obtaining the deliverability test. Also, since the Mesaverde is dually completed with the Pictured Cliffs, we would like to take the Annual Packer Leakage Test immediately following deliverability test. If you approve of this procedure, both zones will be shut in from May 22 to 29, the Mesaverde will be produced from May 29 to June 5, both zones shut in June 5 to 12 and the Pictured Cliffs produced June 12 to 19. After flow from May 29 to June 5, the Mesaverde will remain shut in until the curtailment volume shown in the Shut-In Notice has been made up.
