1. Rigged up workover unit November 12, 1968. Pulled 2" E.U.E. tubing.
2. Ran Casing Corrosion log and Cement bond log in 5-1/2" Casing. Indicated hole in 5-1/2" casing at 3100 ft. D.F.
3. Set 5-1/2" Model "MC" Baker bridge plug at 4070 ft. D.F. Ran 5-1/2" full bore packer set at 2932 ft. Squeezed hole at 3100 ft. w/50 sacks class "C" cement w/2% Calcium Chloride. Job complete 3:30 A.M. 11/13/68. W.O.C. until 9:00 P.M. 11/13/68.
4. Flow well down w/gas; drilled out squeeze cement and bridge plug at 4070 ft. Cleaned out to P.B.T.D. 4171 ft. Well making large amount of water.
5. Flow well until 8:00 P.M. 11/19/68. No decrease in water.
6. Set 5-1/2" Model "MC" Baker bridge plug at 4025 ft. D.F. Perforated & squeeze holes at 3950 ft. D.F.
7. Ran 5-1/2" full bore packer. Set packer at 3821 ft. D.F. Squeezed holes at 3950 ft. w/200 sacks cement. Job complete 6:00 P.M. 11/20/68. W.O.C. until 12 Noon 11/21/68.
8. Flow well down w/gas; drilled out squeeze cement and cleaned out to bridge plug at 4025 ft. Tested hole for water entry. Hole dry.
9. Drilled out bridge plug at 4025 ft. and cleaned out to P.B.T.D. 4171 ft. P.B.T.D.
10. Ran 128 jts. and perf. jt. of 2" E.U.E., 4.70", J-55 Tbg. Landed at 4110 ft. D.F.
11. Workover completed 8:00 P.M. 11/23/68.

Instructions

General: This form is designed for submitting proposals to perform certain well operations, and reports of such operations when completed, as indicated, on Federal and Indian lands pursuant to applicable Federal law and regulations, and, if approved or accepted by any State, on all lands in such State, pursuant to applicable State law and regulations. Any necessary special instructions concerning the use of this form and the number of copies to be submitted, particularly with regard to local, area, or regional procedures and practices, either are shown below or will be issued by, or may be obtained from, the local Federal and/or State office.

Item 4: If there are no applicable State requirements, locations on Federal or Indian land should be described in accordance with Federal requirements. Consult local State or Federal office for specific instructions.

Item 17: Proposals to abandon a well and subsequent reports of abandonment should include such special information as is required by local Federal and/or State offices.
