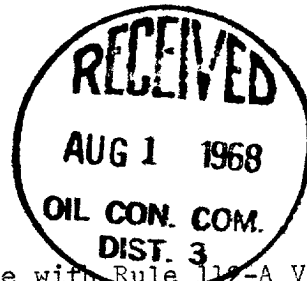

Filed in duplicate herewith, in compliance with Rule 112-A VI of the Commission's Rules and Regulations, is a packer setting affidavit, the gamma ray neutron log taken of this well which includes the Gallup and Dakota perforations used in completing Jicarilla Apache 102 Well No. 9. Approval to dually complete in the Gallup and Basin Dakota pools had been granted by Administrative Order No. MC-1798 dated December 4, 1967.

The results of the packer-leakage tests on this well, which favorably showed effective segregation, will be submitted to your office by our Farmington Area office in the near future. Those test results, when received, along with the enclosed supplemental information should fulfill the required information needed by the Commission on this particular well.
