


THE APPLICATION OF CAULKINS OIL

ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER
OF THE OIL CONSERVATION COMMISSION

Under the provisions of Rule 112-A, Caulkins Oil Company made application to the New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission on May 14, 1962, for permission to dual completion its State "A" Well No. MD-62 located in the NE/4 NE/4 of Section 2, Township 26 North, Range 6 West, NMMPM, Rio Arriba County, New Mexico in such a manner as to permit the production of gas from the Blanco-MesaVerde Pool and the production of gas from the Basin-Dakota Pool.

Now, on this 4th day of June 1962, the Secretary-Director finds:

- (1) That application has been duly filed under the provisions of Rule 112-A of the Commission's Rules and Regulations;
- (2) That satisfactory information has been provided that all operators of offset acreage have been duly notified; and
- (3) That no objections have been received within the waiting period as prescribed by said rule.
- (4) That the proposed dual completion will not cause waste nor impair correlative rights.
- (5) That the mechanics of the proposed dual completion are feasible and consonant with good conservation practices.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

That the applicant herein, Caulkins Oil Company, be and the same is hereby authorized to finally complete its State "A" Well No. MD-62 located in the NE/4 NE/4 of Section 2, Township 26 North, Range 6 West, NMMPM, Rio Arriba County, New Mexico, in such a manner as to permit the production of gas from the Blanco-MesaVerde Pool and the production of gas from the Basin-Dakota Pool during all seasons of the year.

PROVIDED HOWEVER, That applicant shall complete, operate, and produce said well in accordance with the provisions of Rule 112-A.

PROVIDED FURTHER, That said well shall be racker-leakage
