A packer test was conducted on your #25 "W" Well in the NE 1/4
Section 5-26N-5W on January 18, 1957 witnessed by Mr. A. R.
Kendrick of our office. As you know this well is a triple
completion between the Pictured Cliffs, Mesaverde and Dakota
formations. During this test the Mesaverde formation was open
through a 3/4" choke for three hours. The Pictured Cliffs
pressure at the beginning of the test was 1047# and at the
end of the test was 963#. The Dakota Shut-in pressure at
the beginning of the test was 2322# and at the end of the
test was 2329#. It therefore appears that there is communication
between the Pictured Cliffs and Mesaverde portions of this
triple completion. We therefore must direct that you begin
remedial action to separate the zones within the next 15 days.
