- (1) That application has been duly filed under the provisions of Subsection 'c' of Rule 112-A of the Commission's Rules and Regulations;
- (2) That satisfactory information has been provided that all operators of offset acreage have been duly notified; and
- (3) That no objections have been received within the waiting period as prescribed by said rule.
- (4) That the proposed dual completion will not cause waste nor impair correlative rights.
- (5) That the mechanics of the proposed dual completion are feasible and consonant with good conservation practices.

## IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

That the applicant herein, Occidental Petroleum Corporation, be and the same is hereby authorised to dually complete its West Well No. 1-6 located in the NE/4 NE/4 of Section 6, Township 26 North, Range 5 West, NMPM, Rio Arribe County, New Mexico, in such a manner as to permit the production of gas from the Blanco-Mesaverde and the production of gas from the South Blanco-Dakota Pool through parallel strings of tubing, set at 2510 feet and at 7449 feet respectively.

PROVIDED HOWEVER, That at any time the subject well is being worked over, every reasonable effort shall be made to remove the string of tubing which has been dropped into the well, and the Mesaverde tubing set in compliance with Rule 107 (d).
