Gentlemen:

Reference is made to your application for approval of an unorthodox well location for your Rincon Unit Well No. 7 located 55 feet from the North line and 1660 feet from the West line of Section 1, Township 26 North, Range 7 West, South Blanco Pictured Cliffs Gas Pool, Rio Arriba County, New Mexico.

It is our understanding that this unorthodox well location is occasioned by a relocation of section lines as a result of a recent United States Cadastral Survey.

You are hereby granted an exception to Rule 3 of Order R-565-C for the above described unorthodox well location. You must also obtain like approval from the U. S. Geological Survey if the well is located on land subject to the jurisdiction of the U. S. Geological Survey.
