
The packer leakage test started June 24, 1961 on our Breech "E" MD-58, Unit A of section 3-26N-6W, was interrupted because there appeared to be communication between zones.

We have done additional testing and it now appears that the leak was in the well head equipment, which has been repaired. We would therefore like to start another packer leakage test as follows:

Both zones shut in July 16 to 23
Flow upper zone July 24 to 31
Both zones shut in August 1 to 8
Flow lower zone August 9 to August 16.
