It is intended to drill & finally complete a well in the Dakota formation & Mesa Verde formation. Mud circulation will be used thru the Pictured Cliffs & set intermediate casing. Gas circulation will be used thru the middle of the Greenhorn formation & 7" liner will be set. Mud circulation will be used thru the Dakota formation & production liner will be set. Possible productive intervals will be perforated & fractured. Est. T. D. 7558'.

Casing Program:

13 3/8" at 300' w/300 sks. cement circulated to surface.

9 5/8" at 3005' w/200 sks. cement circulated to surface.

7" at 1140' w/300 sks. cement.

5" at 7550' w/100 sks. cement.

The E/2 of Section 6 is dedicated to the Mesa Verde formation.

The E/2 of Section 6 is dedicated to the Dakota formation.

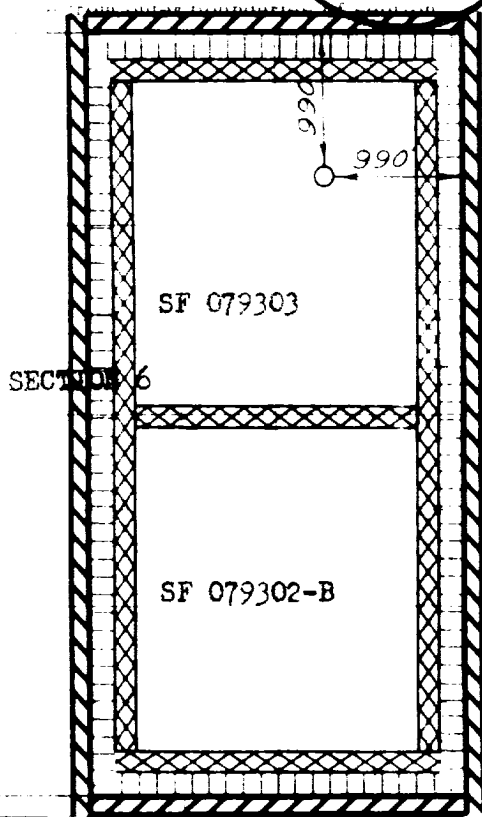
