ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER
OF THE OIL CONSERVATION COMMISSION

Under the provisions of Rule 112-A (c) El Paso Natural Gas Company made application to the New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission on March 15, 1960, for permission to dually complete its Rincon Unit Well No. 150 located in the NE/4 NE/4 of Section 6, Township 26 North, Range 6 West, NMPM, Rio Arriba County, New Mexico, in such a manner as to permit the production of gas from an undesignated Mesaverde Pool adjacent to the Blanco-Mesaverde Pool and the production of gas from the South Blanco-Dakota Pool.

Now, on this 4th day of April, 1960, the Secretary-Director finds:

- (1) That application has been duly filed under the provisions of Sub-section 'c' of Rule 112-A of the Commission's Rules and Regulations;
- (2) That satisfactory information has been provided that all operators of offset acreage have been duly notified; and
- (3) That no objections have been received within the waiting period as prescribed by said rule.
- (4) That the proposed dual completion will not cause waste nor impair correlative rights.
- (5) That the mechanics of the proposed dual completion are feasible and consonant with good conservation practices.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

That the applicant herein, El Paso Natural Gas Company, be and the same is hereby authorized to dually complete its Rincon Unit Well No. 150 located in the NE/4 NE/4 of Section 6, Township 26 North, Range 6 West, NMPM, Rio Arriba County, New Mexico, in such a manner as to permit the production of gas from an undesignated Mesaverde Pool adjacent to the Blanco-Mesaverde Pool and the production of gas from the South Blanco-Dakota Pool through parallel strings of tubing.

PROVIDED HOWEVER, That applicant shall complete, operate, and produce said well in accordance with the provisions of Section V, Rule 112-A.

Under the provisions of Rule 115-A (or El Paso Natural Gas Company made application to the New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission on March 15, 1960, for permission to drill its Rincon Unit Well No. 150 located in the NE 1/4 of Section 2, Township 25 North, Range 6 West, NMPM, Rio Arriba County, New Mexico, in such a manner as to permit the production of gas from an undesignated Mesaverde Pool adjacent to the Blanco Mesaverde Pool and the production of gas from the South Blanco-Bakota Pool.

Now, on this 4th day of April, 1966, the Secretary-Director finds:
