The notice of intention to drill this well listed a proposal to drill with gas from 3600' to 5000', as it was thought that Well "K" No. 1 would be drilled first. Because of problems encountered in constructing a road to "K" No. 1, it is now proposed to drill Well "K" No. 2 first and use low water loss mud with diesel additive 200 to total depth.
