Gentlemen:

This letter is to request authority to use gas from Humble's Jicarilla Apache Tribe of Indians "K" Well No. 2 located 807 feet from North line and 1364 feet from East line of Section 4, T-28-N, R-5-W, Rio Arriba County, New Mexico, to drill Humble's Jicarilla Apache Tribe of Indians "K" Well No. 1 located 2178 feet from North line and 1220 feet from East line of Section 3, T-28-N, R-5-W, Rio Arriba County, New Mexico, Blanco Field.

It is our desire to drill with fluids to a depth of 3600 feet and from 3600 feet to a total depth of 5600 feet using natural gas. This operation would require approximately two and one-half million feet of gas per day, or a total estimated fifteen million feet.
